Our wish list for the coming year include things such as a bladder scanner, used to assess urinary function in a non-invasive manner, 2 bathing lift chairs, along with 2 shower chairs with reclining height-adjustable features to ensure the safety for our residents and staff alike. The list goes on.

We continue to replace items such as pressure reduction mattresses and seat pads, lifting slings and comfort clothing, along with new and comfortable seating in the Rose Garden. Looking to the future we will be redesigning the raised bed gardens in the Rose Garden area making it an even more attractive place to gather when weather is favourable.
