Dear Friends, Family and Supporters;

It has been a busy year at the Kiwanis Pavilion and the Foundation has been working hard throughout. With your support and generosity, we have experienced some significant upgrades and changes for our residents.

We were able to purchase and install a new Bladder Scanner, a bathing lift chair for unit 2A, replace the stove and dishwasher in the activity room and eight over-bed tables. A Yamaha piano was obtained and six 'Concerts in Care' have been booked for the enjoyment of our residents and their families. Outdoor patio tables and chairs as well as some activity room tables were replaced.

This coming year we hope to provide the Pavilion with 24 dining chairs and four recliners. For the safety of our staff and the comfort and security of our residents we are looking to replace slings for the floor lifts at a cost of \$6,000. Specialty comfort and mobility equipment such as pressure reducing mattresses and overhead lift slings are on our list of improvements for 2017/18 at an estimated cost of \$10,000.00.

Changes will be made in the Rose Terrace next spring. The old garden beds have been removed and will be replaced with a new cleaner look. Please remember, you have the opportunity to purchase a Garden Brick to commemorate your loved one. Please contact the Pavilion office if this is an option for you and your family.

Our popular Sunday Breakfasts at the Willows Beach "Tea Room" will start January 7th and continue to April 15th. Also, the popular "Shred It" fundraiser is planned for this spring in the parking lot beside the Tea Room. Funds raised from these events allow us to improve the comfort of our residents.

The 'Salmon Fest' BBQ held in August at Willows Beach was supported by community partners such as the Oak Bay Sea Food Market, 'Chef on the Run', Telus and Oak Bay Parks and Recreation. Fine weather and delicious salmon made for a successful event.
